Policy matters: Managing Conflicts of Interest



In accordance with DSIR policy, the campus encourages development and commercialization of inventions and innovations arising from our research. The campus permits its researchers to have equity stake in scientific enterprises and spinoffs while in professional employment. Our researchers are also permitted to serve in consultant roles or on advisory boards of external organizations, provided such roles are not in conflict with their primary responsibilities to the campus. Attempts of our researchers to balance campus responsibilities with external activities can result in conflicts regarding

allocation of time and energies. A new policy has been developed that addresses these conflicts and how they may be managed (see https://www.ncbs.res.in/rdo/research policies).

The RDO is first point of contact for all potential sponsorship of research on campus from philanthropic and for-profit sources.


P Kariappa
