- 4. The validity of your quotation should be for 60 days from the due date.
- 5.All duties, taxes, surcharge and cess as currently applicable must be stated in yourquotation, separately. Otherwise your quote is liable to be rejected.
- 6. Your quotation should indicate delivery period & warranty period.
- 7.Delivery to be made to our stores. Please indicate charges, if any extra. Transit Insurance should be done upto NCBS Stores.
- 8.If you are unable to supply the quality, specifications or brand as mentioned in our enquiry, please state so and then offer alternative to quality/specifications.
- 9. Payment: within one month after delivery & acceptance/satisfactory installation.

- 12.If the item is covered under DGS&D rate contract, please quote the rate as per the DGS&D rate contract with xerox copy of the DGS&D order.

13. Any dispute or differences that may arise between the parties shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the Centre Director or his nominees. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties. The venue for arbitration shall be Bangalore. The provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time shall apply. The courts in Bangalore shall have exclusive jurisdiction to deal with any or all disputes between the parties.

14.Liquidity Damages:If the equipment/ items as per specifications in our P.O. is not supplied (shipped) within the specified delivery schedule, then liquidated damages (not in terms of penalty) will be imposed automatically and shall be deducted from the bill at the rate of 0.5% per week subject to a maximum of 10% of the order value.

Ultra Low Temperature, Vertical Upright type -86° C Deep Freezer

- 1. Operating temperature range should be from -50°C to -86°Cat ambient temperature of 35-degree C. It must maintain -80°C under normal working condition
- 2. System should be vertical standing and should have working volume of 950 Ltr (± 5%)
- 3. System should have minimum four shelves with individual inner SS 304 doors with gasket and independent door hinges and latches.
- 4. System should be equipped with precise temperature controller with accuracy of \pm 2°C & it should maintain uniform temperature in freezer.
- 5. System should have pressure equalization port (PEP).
- 6. System should be fully programmable microprocessor controlled with keypad and eye level touch control panel.
- 7. System should have digital display with capacitive touch control for all functions (even touching with the gloves). The digital display should be clear, easy to read LCD/LED display and USB for exporting the data.
- 8. System should have on board diagnostics digital display allows for quicker diagnosis of problem minimizing downtime.
- 9. System should have low/high voltage protection, surge protection to minimize potential damage from voltage spikes.
- 10. System should be equipped with buzzer and visual alarm for power failure and temperature deviation against the setup temperature or any temperature deviation should trigger audible and visual warning.
- 11. System should have inbuilt on-board diagnostic digital Log data storage for Temperature and alarms Data must also be downloadable via a USB port.
- 12. The Freezer shall have two- 1-inch access ports as standard.
- 13. The Freezer door must open at least 180 degrees for easy sample access.
- 14. The Freezer shall allow set-point security control that blocks specific users from changing freezer set point or alarms through the use of a user name and password control and should allow multiple users.
- 15. The system should have the filter less design to eliminate the need of cleaning the filters.
- 16. The system should record the temperature and history of the freezer for life time
- 17. System should have robust and silent compressor with noise level less than 45 db.
- 18. The freezer door recovery time should be less than 12minutes (± 10%)
- 19. System should have advanced cooling system with high power efficient compressor units like inverter type or dual cooling system
- 20. System should have HFC Free Natural refrigerants compliant with EU F-Gas regulation.
- 21. System should have NO-NC contacts for connection to remote monitoring system.
- 22. System should have connectivity port for BMS control for all the parameters required for monitoring.
- 23. System should have enhanced acoustic insulation.
- 24. The system should meet the international safety standards and CE, ISO 9001, ISO13485, USFDA Marked or equivalent marked.
- 25. System should be offered with 5-year OEM warranty as part of offer (not as extra item).
- 26. System should have door handle and latch assembly with standard key lock.
- 27. System should have supplied with factory installed electronic door access control system with minimum 5 user key cards or Fingerprint
- 28. The system should be supplied with Cryo gloves and additional Air filter.
- 29. Offer should have reference of minimum 5 similar research institute for installation and satisfactory performance and should be submitted with the quotation

- 30. System should be suitable for power rating 230v, 50Hz single phase. System should have battery backup for controller, display and alarm.
- 31. System should be highly energy efficient.
- 32. Offer should have the average power consumption per day at normal condition.
- 33. Compliance to each of the above points should be separately indicated and evidence presence for each of them (Product brochures should be highlighted wherever required). Certificate of calibration and inspection from factory to be supplied with system.
- 34. System should be offered with suitable 5kva voltage stabilizer.
- 35. The system should be installed by the trained Engineer and users training should be given on Application, operation and maintenance
