FUNDING NEWS



VAJRA (Visiting Advanced Joint Research) Faculty scheme

The Department of Science and Technology (DST) has recently launched VAJRA (Visiting Advanced Joint Research), a new scheme to enable overseas scientists to work as adjunct/visiting faculty for a specific period of time at Indian Public funded academic and research institutions. The Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB), a Statutory body of the Department will implement the scheme.

The VAJRA scheme is open to Non-resident Indians (NRI) and Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) / Overseas Citizen of India (OCI).

VAJRA Faculty members will carry out research in close coordination with researchers at the Indian host institution and will work for a minimum of 1 month and a maximum of 3 months a year at an institution in India. This position will initially be offered for a period of 1 year, and can be renewed every year.

VAJRA Faculty members will be provided lump-sum amounts of USD 15000 and USD 10000 in the first and subsequent months, respectively, to cover their travel and honorarium. No separate support is provided for accommodation, medical / personal insurance etc. which may be covered by the host institute.

Research grants/Fellowships

Program Grants (Human Frontier in Science Program, HFSP)

Remit: To support innovative basic research into fundamental biological problems with emphasis placed on novel and interdisciplinary approaches that involve scientific exchanges across national and disciplinary boundaries.

Applicant Eligibility: Independent PI at any stage of their career. The research teams (consisting of 2-4 team members) must be international. The principal applicant must be from one of the eligible countries (India is eligible).

Budget: Up to \$450,000 per grant per year

Duration: 3 years

Deadline: Submission of letter of intent by 30th March, 2017. Online registration deadline is 20th March, 2017.

Young Investigators' Grants (Human Frontier in Science Program, HFSP)

Remit: To support young scientists in their early career to establish novel collaborations with scientists from different disciplines (e.g. from chemistry, physics, computer science, engineering) to focus on problems in the life sciences.

Applicant Eligibility: All members of the team must be within 5 years of obtaining an independent position and must have obtained their first doctoral degree not longer than 10 years before the deadline for submission of the letter of intent.

Budget: Up to \$450,000 per grant per year

Applicant eligibility: At least three legal entities. Each of the three must be established in a different EU Member State or Horizon 2020 associated country (India eligible in this call). All three legal entities must be independent of each other.

Budget: 19,000,000 €
