DBT Alumni Scheme for Newton International Fellows (NIFs)

The Department of Biotechnology (DBT) in collaboration with Academy of Medical Sciences under the auspices of the Newton- Bhabha Fund is implementing the "follow-on" DBT Alumini Scheme for Newton-International Fellows (Alumini-NIFs) upon their return to India.

The scheme will provide support to Newton International Fellows (NIFs) from India, leaving the UK and returning to India to continue their research career in Indian institution as faculty/fellow/scientist/associate after the completion of their fellowship or after undertaking the fellowship for at least 18 months in UK.

Funding of Rs. 5 lakh per annum will be provided upto a maximum duration of 5 years to for collaborative travel and subsistence.



Remit: To provide financial and practical support to young scientists in the life sciences in the early stages of setting up an independent laboratory to help them develop skills and connections that will help them during this career stage.

Applicant Eligibility: 1-4 years of experience as an independent group leader. Carry out research in the life sciences in an EMBC Member State, an EMBC Associate Member State (India is now an EMBC Associate Member State) or a cooperating partner country (currently Taiwan). Age limit < 40 years. **Duration:** 3 years

Research Grants/ Fellowships

Small Grants program (Ravi Sankaran Foundation)

Remit: To support conservation research for unconventional or risky projects within India that has the potential to lead to a longer-term conservation science and/or implementation project.

Applicant Eligibility: Indian national with demonstrated interest in wildlife ecology and conservation. Age limit < 30 years. **Budget:** stipend and project expenses (upto Rs 2 lakh per year in total)

Duration: 1 year

CRP-ICGEB Early Career Return Grants (ICGEB)

Remit: To fund young researchers who have recently returned from abroad to an ICGEB Member State to establish their own independent laboratories.

Applicant Eligibility: Should have spent a minimum of 2 years abroad. Age limit < 40 years. Should have taken up, or are about to take up, a position as an Independent Investigator in an ICGEB Member State.

Duration: 5 years

Deadline: 30th April, 2018

Core Research Grant (DST-SERB)

Remit: To support scientists for undertaking research in frontier areas of S&T in Life Sciences, Physical Sciences, Chemical Sciences, Engineering Sciences, Earth & Atmospheric Sciences & Mathematical Sciences

Applicant eligibility: PhD, Regular position in Indian research institutes/universities

Budget: Up to Rs. 80 lakhs. Projects above Rs. 80 lakhs may be considered by the Empowered Committee on case to case basis. **Duration**: 3 years

International Collaboration

DBT-European Commission H2020 call (2017-18) (DBT/EU, Europe)

Remit: To support collaborative research proposals between scientists in India and Europe on projects related to broad thematic areas including biotechnology, rural renaissance, food security, health and bio-energy.

Applicant eligibility: Eligible Indian participants are researchers from recognised public/private funded academic or research institutions, national R&D laboratories

Budget: Funding includes costs for manpower, consumables, equipment, travel and for organizing conferences and workshops.

Duration: 3-5 years

Deadline: The deadlines vary for the different themes. 5th April, 2018 (Bio-energy); 18th April, 2018 (Health); 25th April, 2018 (Biotechnology).

Indo-Swiss Joint Research Programme (ISJRP), 2018-19 (DBT/SNSF, Switzerland)

Remit: To promote collaborative research projects among researchers between India and Switzerland in thematic areas including basic life sciences (biotechnology-related/inspired), agriculture, environment, energy, materials sciences, health, medicine, industrial biotechnology.

Applicant eligibility: At least one partner based in Switzerland and one based in India. Applicants should be researchers from public and private universities, colleges, institutes, non- profit organizations.

Budget: Upto CHF 350000. Funding includes costs for manpower, consumables, equipment, travel and for organizing conferences and workshops.

Duration: Upto 4 years

International Collaboration

Collaborative Research Programme (CRP) - ICGEB Research Grants (ICGEB)

Remit: To promote collaborative research projects among researchers between ICGEB Member States (<u>http://www.icgeb.org/member-states.html</u>) and with the ICGEB Component laboratories in disciplines including basic life sciences, human healthcare, industrial and agricultural biotechnology and bioenergy.

Applicant eligibility: Regular positions at Universities or Research Institutes in any of the ICGEB Member States (India is eligible).

Budget: Euro 25,000/ year. Funding includes costs for consumables, equipment, travel and training.

Duration: Upto 36 months

Deadline: 30th April, 2018

Comment: Applications need to be first submitted to the National Liasion Officer for endorsement. Maximum of 3 applications may be endorsed by each country. Liaison Officers will inform ICGEB regarding the endorsed applications in the present call.

Postdoctoral Fellowships

National Post Doctoral Fellowship, N-PDF (SERB)

Remit: Provides support to pursue postdoctoral research in frontier areas of science and engineering.

Applicant eligibility: Indian citizen, PhD. Applicants who have submitted their PhD/M.D/M.S thesis and are awaiting award of the degree are also eligible to apply. Age limit < 35 years

Budget: Rs. 55,000/- per month (consolidated), research grant: Rs. 2,00,000/- per annum

Travel

Ravi Sankaran Fellowship Program Internship (Inlaks Shivdasani Foundation)

Remit: To fund one or two recipients to carry out an internship with a university research group, NGO, government agency or other organisation, known for its work in conservation science and practice in a country other than India.

Applicant eligibility: Indian national with demonstrated interest in wildlife ecology and conservation. Age limit < 30 years. **Budget:** Stipend, internship fees, to-and-fro international travel (upto USD 1,500 for travel).

Duration: 6 weeks to 1 year

Remit: Travel grant for graduate students and post-doctoral researchers who wish to make collaborative visits.

Applicant eligibility: No restriction on nationality. The applicant should be working in the field of the journal (Development, Journal of Cell Science, The Journal of Experimental Biology, and Disease Models & Mechanisms)

Budget: up to £2,500. Funding includes travel, subsistence, accommodation, visa fees and bench fees.

Scientific Meetings grant (Company of Biologists)

Remit: To fund the organisation of meetings/ workshops. **Applicant eligibility:** Organiser must have a PhD. No geographic restrictions, preference to events with feasible diversity in speakers in terms of geography, gender and age.

Budget: Funds for organizing meetings, support of young scientists and plenary or keynote speakers attending meetings. **Agency Deadline:** 5th June, 2018

Remit: To improve the understanding, diagnosis and treatment of autism spectrum disorders (ASD) by funding innovative research of the highest quality and relevance.

Applicant eligibility: All applicants and key collaborators must hold a Ph.D., M.D. or equivalent degree and have a faculty position or the equivalent at a college, university, medical school or other research facility. There are no citizenship or country requirements.

Remit: To support faculty exchange in order to strengthen existing collaborations between India and Cambridge

Industry Relevant R&D (SERB)

Remit: To utilize the expertise available in academic institutions and national laboratories to solve industry specific problems for the larger benefit of society.

Applicant eligibility: Academic partners include Indian nationals holding a regular academic appointment in India. All industries (including MSME & industrial R&D Centres) are eligible.

Budget: SERB will provide funds up to Rs.50 lakhs for supporting research costs to the academic partner. The industry partner is expected to share up to 50% of the total costs of the project.

Duration: 3-5 years

J C Bose National Fellowships (SERB)

Remit: To recognize active scientists and engineers for their outstanding performance and contributions.

Applicant eligibility: Indian Nationals residing in India, with upper age limit of 68 years for completion of fellowship. Needs to be nominated by the institute.

Budget: Salary top-up of Rs. 25,000 per month plus research grant of Rs. 10.00 lakh.

Duration: 5 years

Budget: Fellowship support of Rs.85,000/- per month and research grant of 7 Lakhs per annum

Duration: 5 years
