

The use of materials or their copies from the NCBS Research Collections is governed by the following guidelines, and legally binding rules and regulations:

1. The NCBS Research Collections ("NCBS") grants the undersigning visitors/staff access to the Items deposited in NCBS, which may include inspection, photography, videography, X-ray imaging and other type of documentation, as mutually agreed, of the Items deposited in NCBS.
2. The visitors/staff should assign full title guarantee to NCBS, its successors, licensees and assigns, the worldwide copyright and rights in the nature of copyright in all Reproductions¹ of the Items (where relevant by present assignment of future copyright) for the full period of copyright. The copyright may be extended and renewed at the sole discretion of NCBS and/or following national and international laws and regulations. This includes all publication rights in all media by any means whether now known or invented in the future.
3. Although the copyright for the Reproductions is assigned to NCBS, the visitors/staff are at liberty to use the Reproductions for private, personal, research, and non-commercial educational purposes (i.e., lectures, presentations, temporary displays, websites for which no admission or other charges are made). NCBS should be acknowledged as copyright holder wherever the Reproductions are used.
4. Should the visitors/staff wish to use the Reproductions in any other context, including a commercial context (including without limitation issuing, renting or lending copies of any or all the reproductions to the public), they must obtain prior written consent of NCBS (via the Faculty Coordinator of the Research Collections). They should understand and acknowledge that they may be charged a fee for this privilege.
5. Visitors/staff who have signed this document are not allowed to transfer the Reproductions, except in the contexts outlined in Pt. 3 and 4, to any other parties who have not signed this document, without prior permission from NCBS.
